Lifeguards ensure that the rules and regulations that apply to the pool are observed by patrons using the facility, and are responsible for preventing accidents and rescuing distressed swimmers. Lifeguards have considerable responsibility for the exercise of sound judgment in emergency situations. Does related work as required.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** None.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Possession of appropriate lifeguard training and cardiopulmonary resuscitation certifications as required by the New York State Sanitary Code at the time of appointment and maintenance of said certifications for the duration of employment.
2. Must be at least sixteen (16) years of age to be eligible for appointment.
