The City of Ithaca is seeking highly qualified transfer applicants to fill immediate Police Officer openings. The Ithaca Police Department prides itself on providing its officers with the best training possible and the best equipment available. IPD officers are focused on working together with the community to reduce crime and to help maintain Ithaca as a safe place to live, work and visit.

2023 HIRING SALARIES

Police Officers from municipal police departments or Sheriff's Departments in New York State with 2 or more years of experience: **\$79,822** at hire, step increase to **\$89,885** after one year.

Police Officers from municipal police departments or Sheriff's Departments in New York State with 1-2 years of experience: **\$72,305** at hire, step increase to **\$79,822** after one year, step increase to **\$89,885** after two years.

SUNY Police Officers, NYS Park Police Officers, NYS DEC Police Officers: **\$57,461** at hire, step increase to **\$72,305** after one year, step increase to **\$79,822** after two years, step increase to **\$89,885** after three years.

HIRING BONUS

Police Officers who transfer to the Ithaca Police Department and commit to two years of service will receive a **\$20,000 hiring bonus**. \$10,000 will be paid upon hire; \$10,000 will be paid after completion of the first year of employment.

TRANSFER QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates must be eligible for transfer or reinstatement as a Police Officer pursuant to § 58 and § 70 of NYS Civil Service Law and the City of Ithaca Civil Service Rules, including:

- Current employment, or past employment within 12 months, as a permanently appointed competitive class Police Officer or Deputy Sheriff with a NYS municipality, the NYS Park Police, the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, or the SUNY Police. Permanent appointment must have come from a civil service eligible list established pursuant to NYS Civil Service Law.

Please Note: NYC Police Officers (all agencies) and NYS Troopers are not eligible for transfer.

- Current Police Officer certification from the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services.
- A valid NYS Class D driver license or equivalent.

- MPTC certification for Basic Course for Police Officers
