The position will serve as either a project manager or support staff for planning activities, including comprehensive and neighborhood planning and evaluation, land use policy amendments, and reviewing and evaluating development applications. Candidates with experience or interest in housing, land use and zoning are encouraged to apply.

**Position Description:** The work involves responsibility for developing, implementing and managing municipal planning projects. The incumbent performs a variety of professional planning activities and services either as project manager or support staff for planning projects. The incumbent also conducts multifaceted research and analysis, community outreach, provides technical advice to municipal officials, and prepares applications for and administers grant funds. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Director of Planning and Development with considerable latitude allowed for the exercise of independent judgment in the performance of the work. Supervision may be exercised over student interns. Does related work as required.

Possession of a Bachelor's degree in planning, architecture, landscape architecture, urban design, historic preservation, public administration, public policy, economic development, engineering, environmental studies or a closely related field with similar course curriculum and one (1) year of full-time paid experience, or its part-time paid and/or volunteer equivalent, in municipal, community or regional planning; or

C. An equivalent combination or training and experience as defined by limits of (a) and (b).

Note: College degrees must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education and/or U.S. Secretary of Education. If an applicant's degree was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, the applicant must provide independent verification of equivalency.
